Inspire Inclusion: Count her in

The Women Business Council of the Madras Chamber of Commerce and Industry, conducted a women's day event centred on the theme of "Inspire Inclusion: Count her in". This was an event in celebration of International Women's Day.





Inaugural Session

The Secretary General, Ms. Saraswathi K, introduced the Madras Chamber and its activities briefly.

The MCCI President, Mr. T. R. Kesavan, spoke about the importance of women recognizing and grabbing opportunities instead of expecting other's to bring change they need to lead the way to ensuring their equity.

Ms Bhavani Balasubramaniam, the Chairperson of the Women Business Council (WBC), spoke about the various activities of the WBC since its inception and also shared data on how women have been progressing in the professional sphere with more women being offered leadership positions and more women joining the workforce at various levels.

The chief guest for the session was Dr Kala Vijayakumar, Pro Chancellor, Shiv Nadar University, Chennai & President, SSN Institutions, who gave a talk centred on the UN Theme for International Women's Day 2024, "Invest in Women: Accelerate Progress". Her presentation encapsulated the importance of this theme through referencing the life story of Savitribai Phule, the first female teacher and social reformer. She also spoke about the importance of extending opportunities to all women, so that they can overcome social situations and financial hardships to pursue their education and careers.WBC since its inception and also shared data on how women have been progressing in the professional sphere with more women being offered leadership positions and more women joining the workforce at various levels.



Technical Session 1: Corporate Gender inclusive initiatives



The first technical session was delivered by Mr. R. Anandakrishnan, President – HR & IT, TVS Motor Company Ltd. He spoke about how corporates can create gender inclusive environments, speaking from the example of TVS.

He detailed the various schemes that TVS has devised in order to ensure that their women employees grow in their careers. This allowed the audience to gain a view of how a corporate can be pro-inclusion with planning and commitment.



Technical Session 2: Promoting a caring Society



This session was delivered by Dr Kalpana Shankar, Chairperson & Managing Trustee, Hand in Hand. She spoke about the various cultural barriers that women face that is a result of upbringing and society that prevent them from reaching their goals in their careers and business. She encouraged the formation of forums that would promote women mentoring as they are an essential part of learning and development. She concluded saying that women need to advocate more for themselves and put themselves first especially when it comes to their career growth.

Technical Session 3: Gender Responsive Financing

This session was delivered by Ms. Bama Balakrishnan, Chief Operating Officer, Northern Arc Capital. She spoke about the importance of understanding financial wellbeing for women. Her talk detailed on areas of gender budgeting and investing in women as a community. She insisted that reach and delivery of financial services is critical for women and the easier we make the reach, it is more likely that women will invest and gain financial freedom. She also spoke about the importance of schemes that are targeted towards women entrepreneurs and micro investments in order to encourage higher participation by women. She concluded with the thought that women need to step forward and take charge of their own finances.



The session concluded with a Q&A session with the speakers and Ms Madhri G, Co-Chairperson, WBC, delivered the vote of thanks appreciating the inputs given by the speakers.
